G-MOTO CHALLENGE: AN ALL-INCLUSIVE PACKAGE

In order to help bikers who would like to participate in the Silk Way Rally at a lower cost, the organizers have decided to set up the G-MOTO CHALLENGE (malle moto). This category, limited to the first 15 participants registered, is reserved for amateur riders only, who are not part of the FIM priority list or the ASO Elite list who enter without any

competitors will set off for two legs in the heart of Eastern Siberia and the Russian Taiga where the driving will be intense, before tackling the Altai, its mountainous landscapes and its more technical tracks for the last leg in Russia.

7 STAGES TO DISCOVER WESTERN MONGOLIA

Change of country and change of scenery from the 4th leg, that will be the first of the seventh stages run in Mongolia. Competitors will discover the Country of the Blue Sky, on a route where road sections will be shorter and special stages longer, "alternating" between the mountains, lakes, vast steppes and sand dunes. Between navigation, driving, crossings, fast and technical tracks, all the ingredients of rally-raid will be present in the desert immensity of the country of Genghis Khan.

SILK WAY RALLY 2021. COVID-19 SANITARY MEASURES

In the context of the current COVID-19 pandemic, the organisers of the international Silk Way Rally are working on a range of sanitary protocols and procedures necessary to ensure the successful running of the event.

Measures designed to prevent and eliminate the risk of propagation of COVID-19 include: PCR test for all rally participants and organisers, regularly taking of body temperature, compulsory wearing of masks, regular washing of hands, respect of social distancing, separation of flows of competitors and organisers. The organisational structure will be adapted to these new conditions.

In addition, a compulsory contacts research procedure will be introduced and a package of measures will be developed to guarantee the isolation of people if they are suspected of being unwell.

The start and finish ceremony formats, as well as press conferences, will also be modified.

The event will be run conforming strictly to directives and regulations approved by Rospotrebnadzor (*) and local health authorities, as well as FIA and FIM
